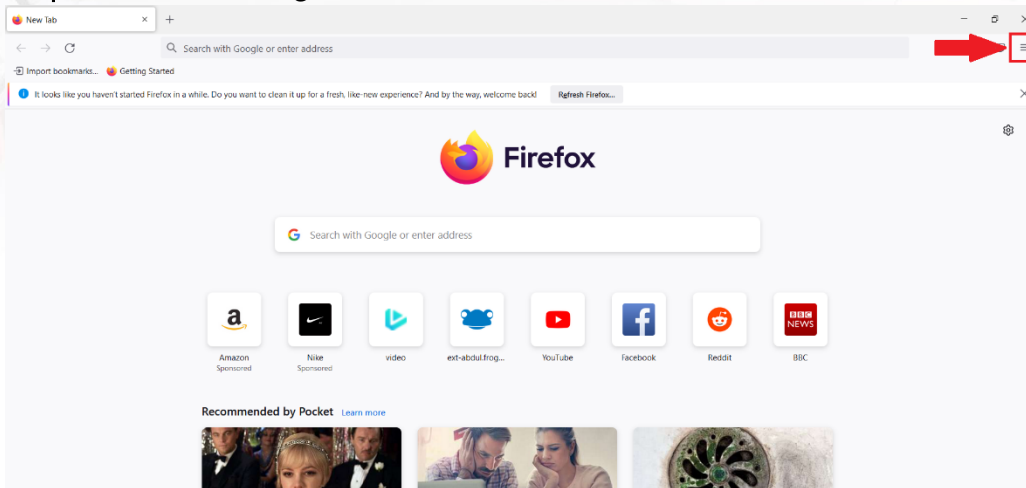

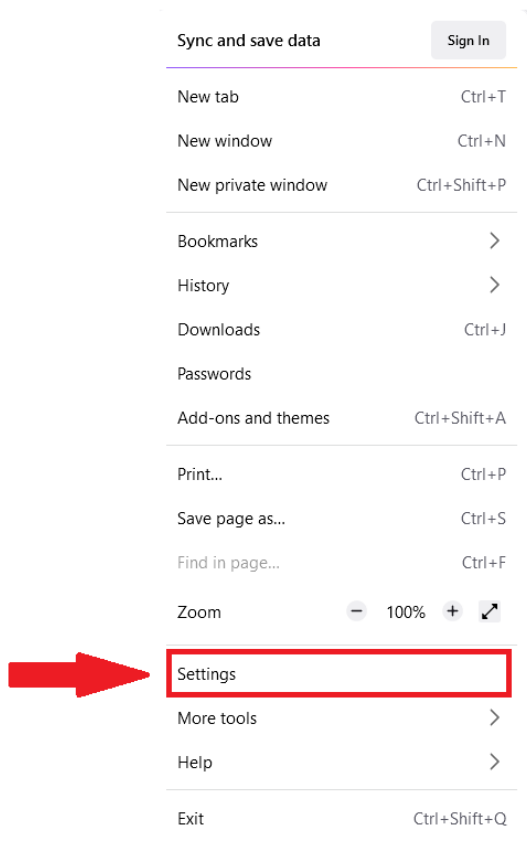

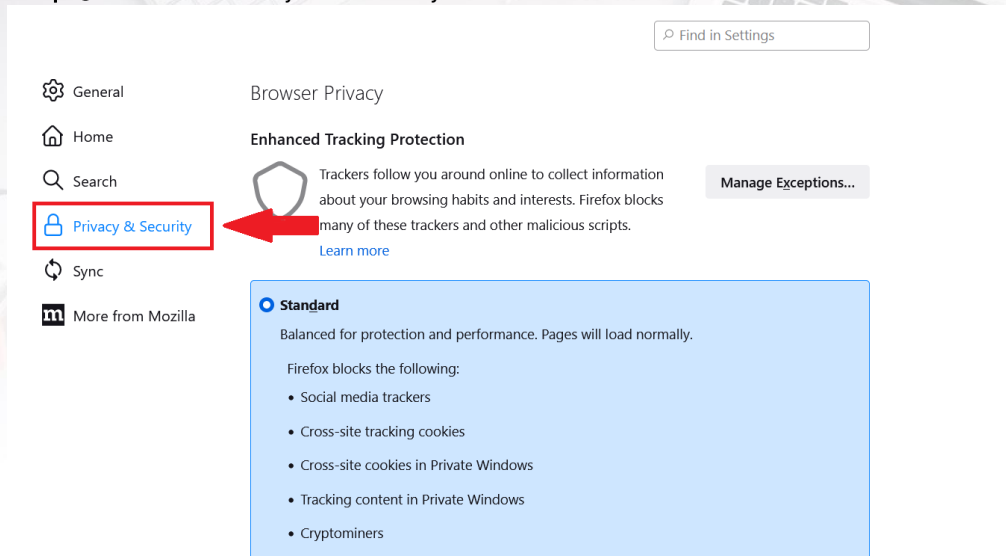
**Step 1.** Select the burger menu

### Step 3. Select Privacy & Security

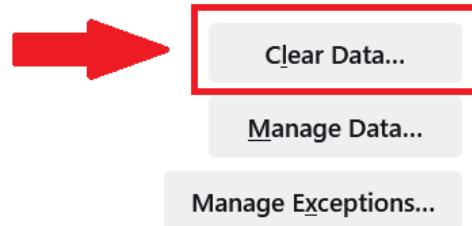


### Step 4. Under the heading Cookies and Site Data select "Clear Data"

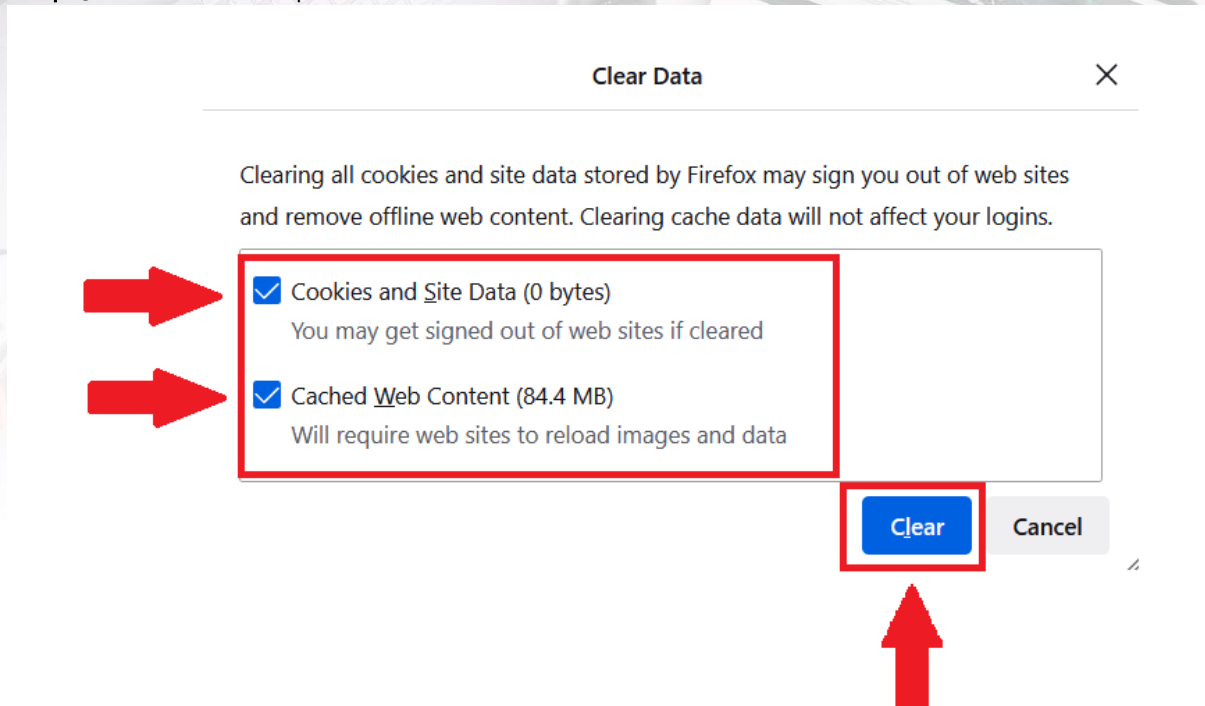

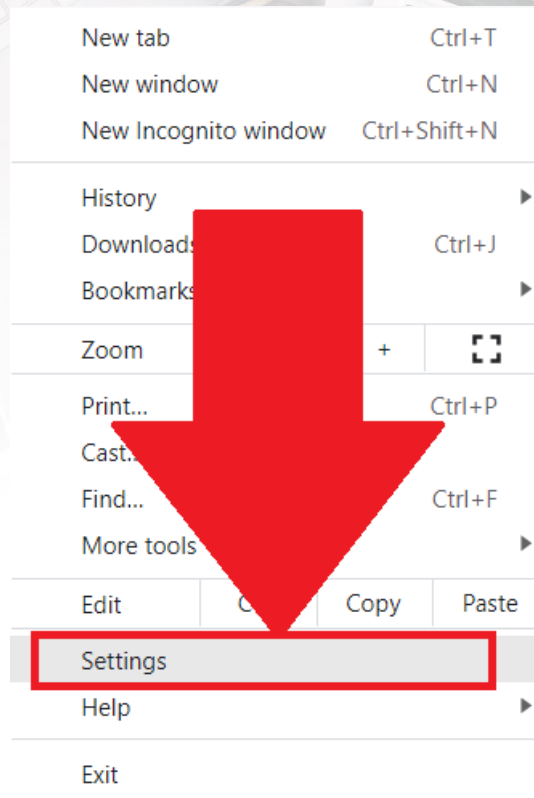
**Step 1.** Open Google Chrome on your machine.



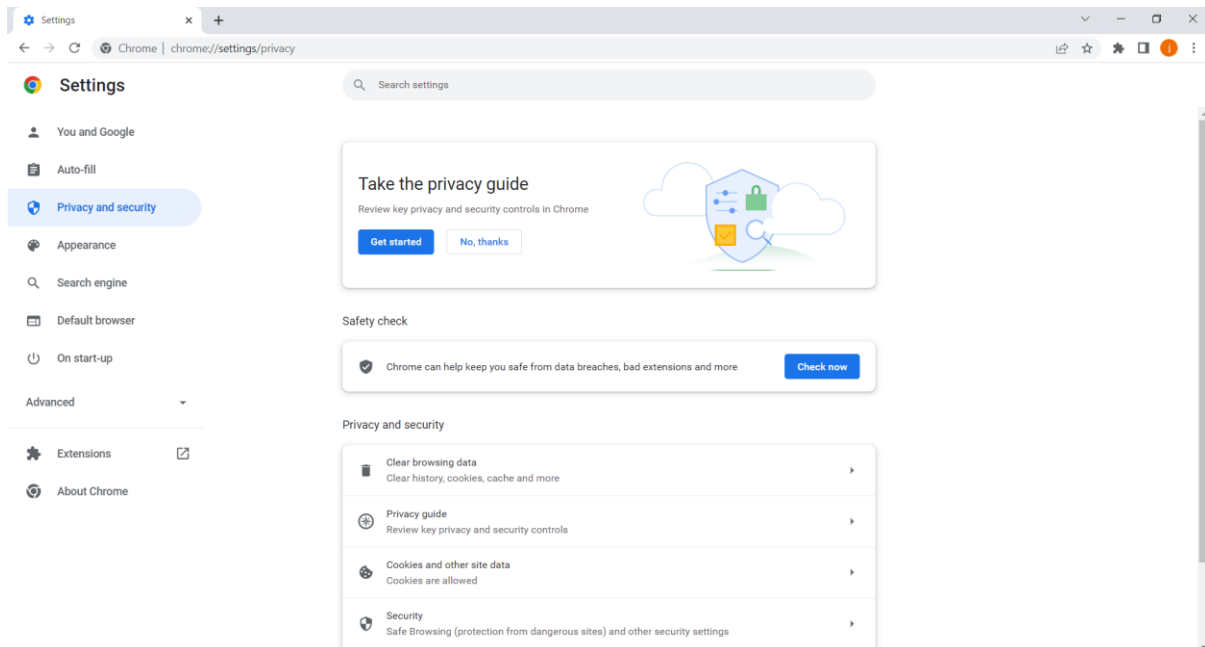
**Step 2.** Click the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner of the browser.



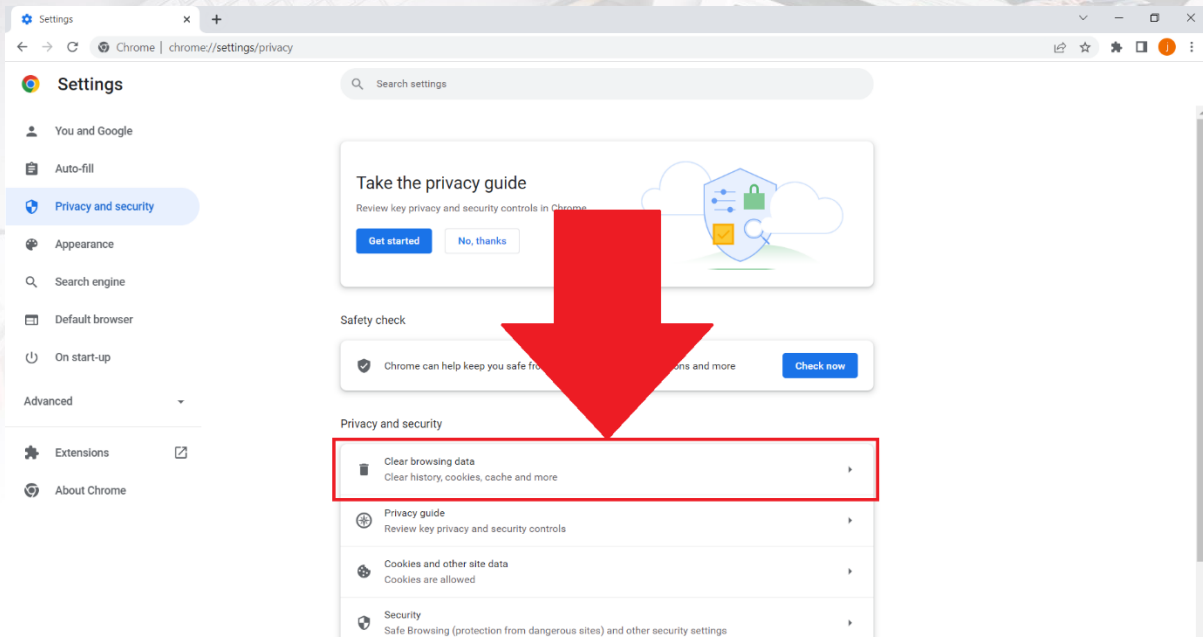
Step 3. Select Settings from the drop-down menu.



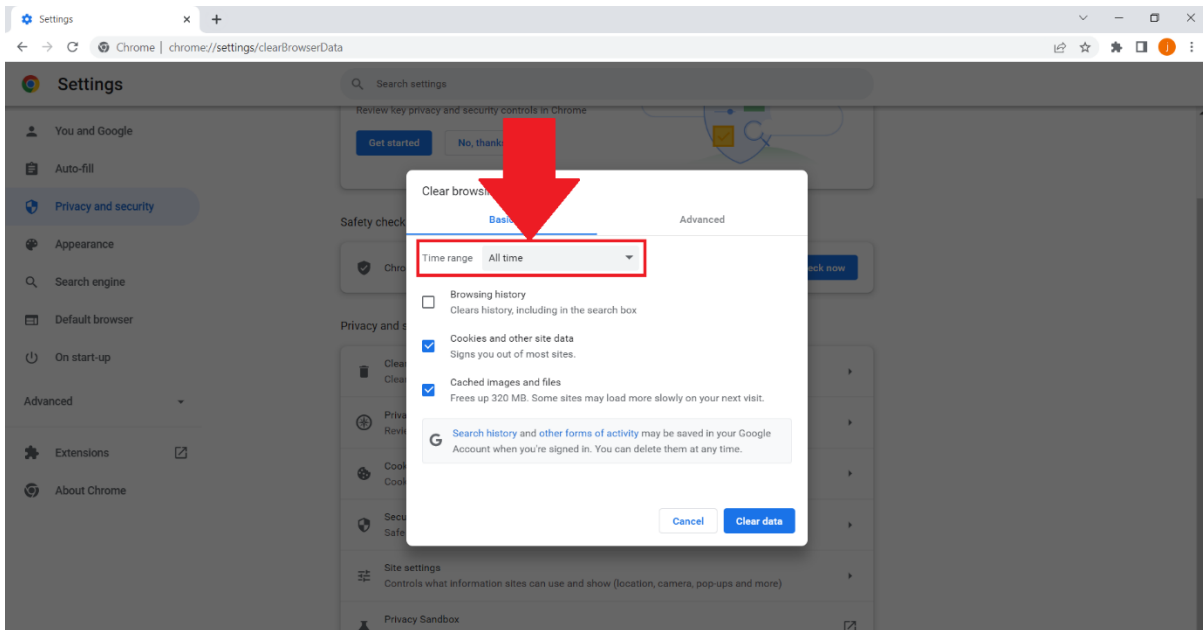
Step 4. Select "Privacy and Security" from the left-hand menu.



Step 5. Select "Clear Browsing data".

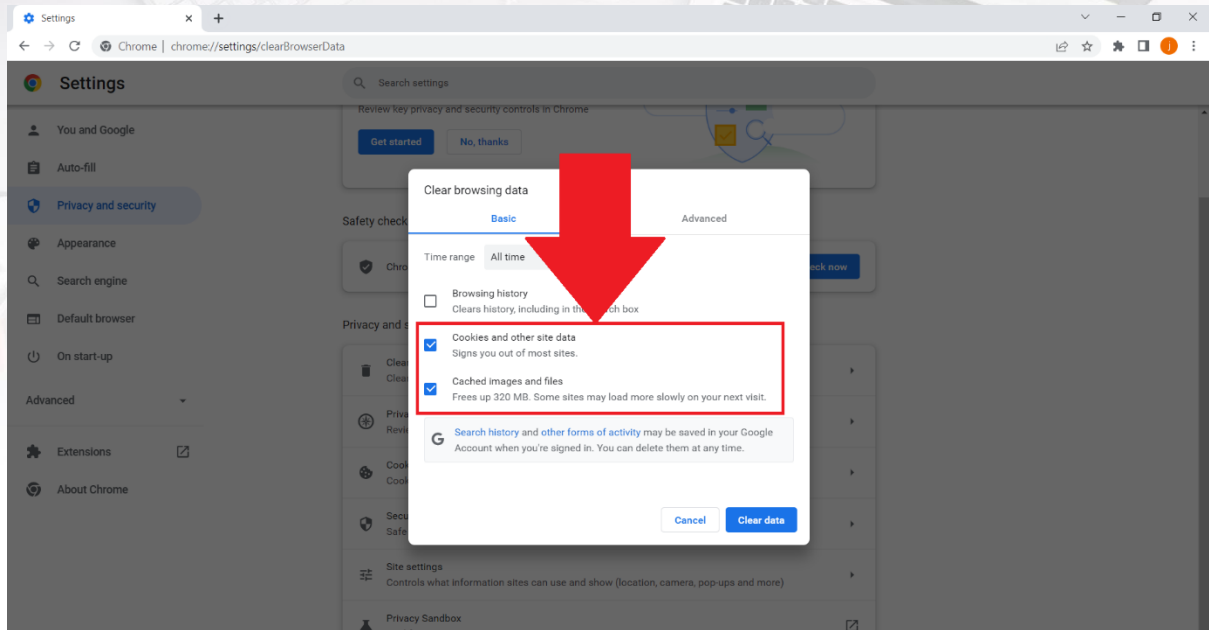


Step 6. In the "Time Range" drop down make sure "All Time" is selected.

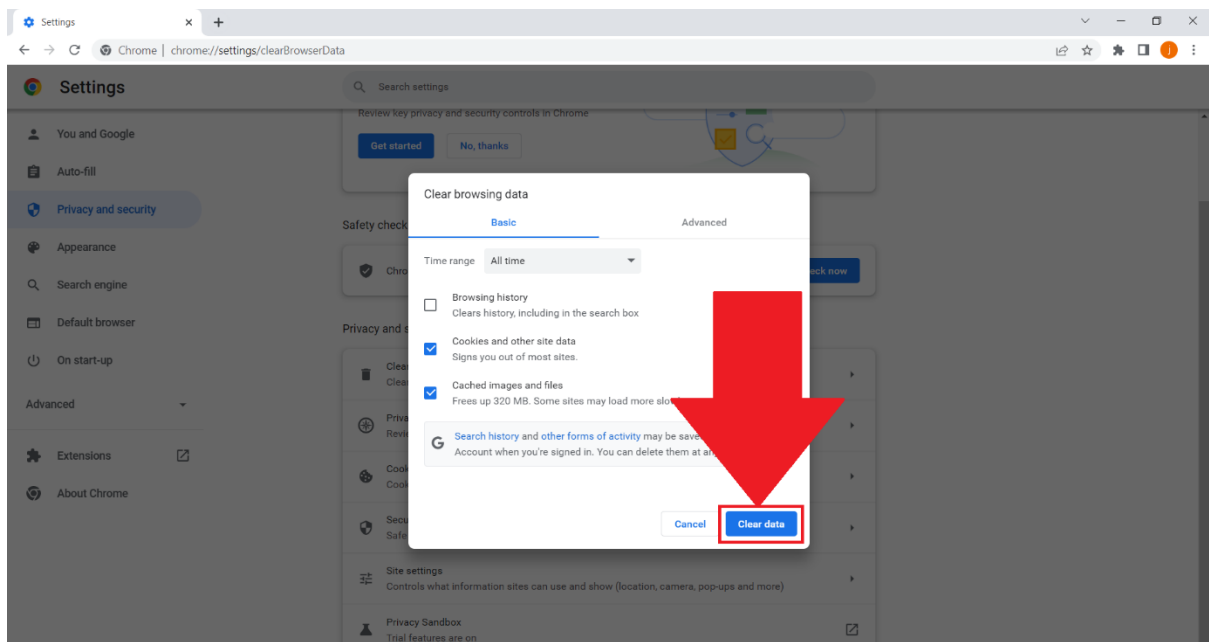




**Step 7.** Make sure *both*, "Cookies and other site data" and "Cached images and files" are ticked.



**Step 8.** Click the "Clear Data" button.

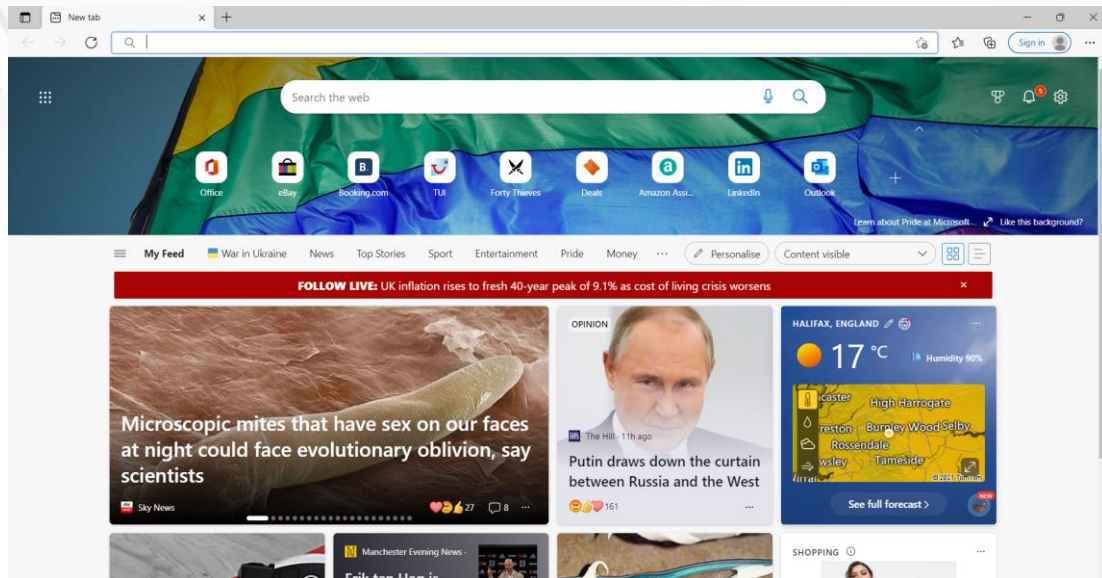

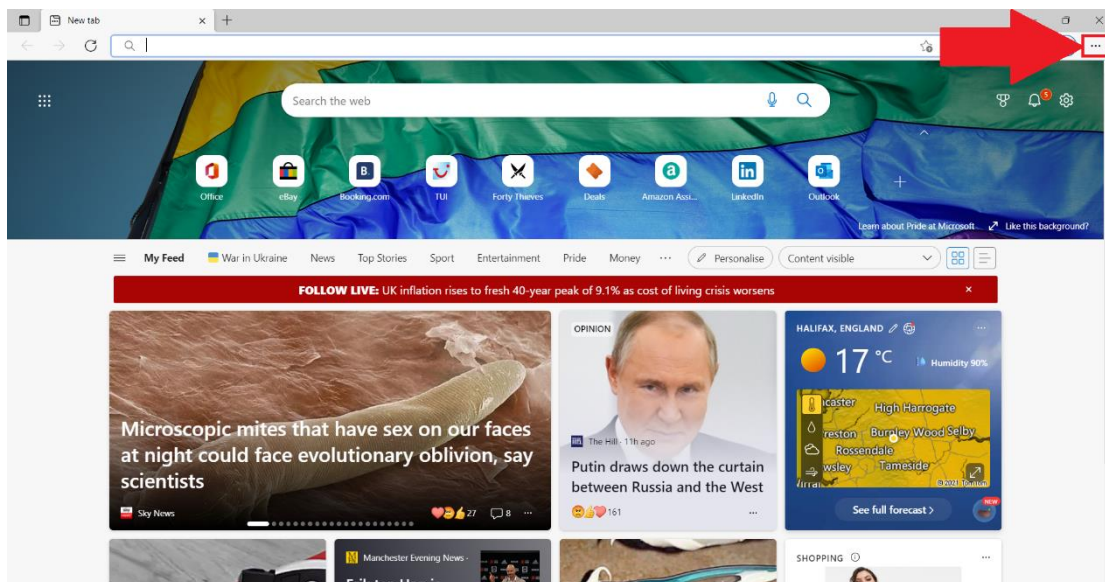

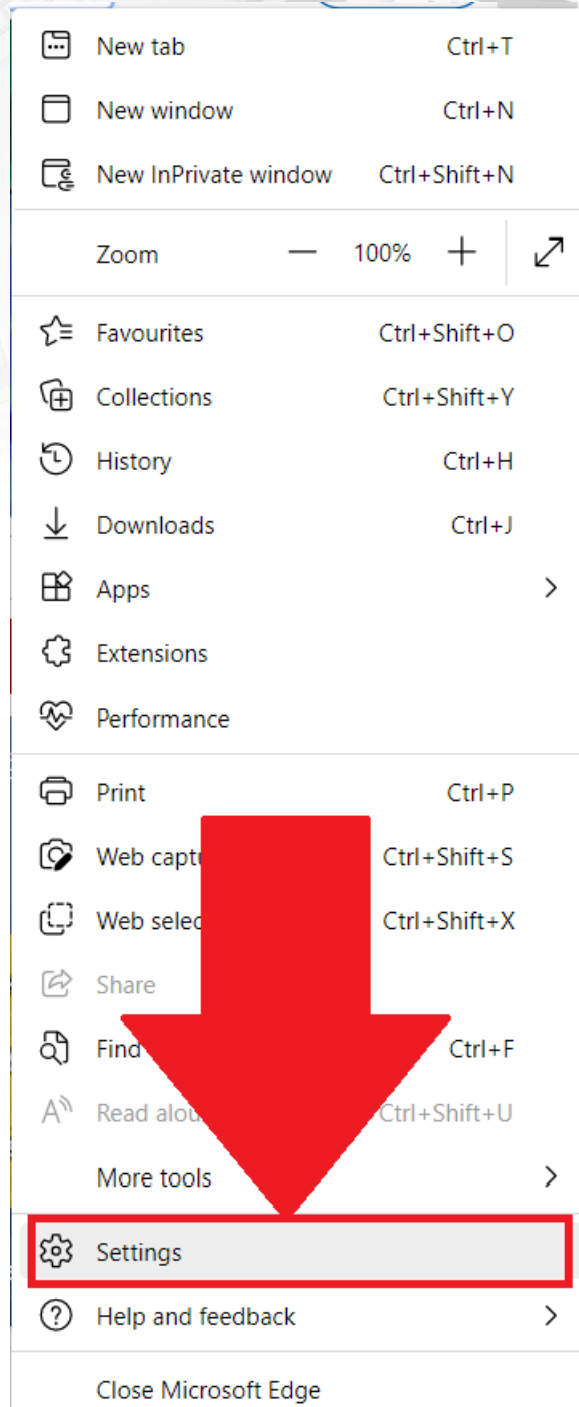
**Step 1.** Open Microsoft Edge on your machine.



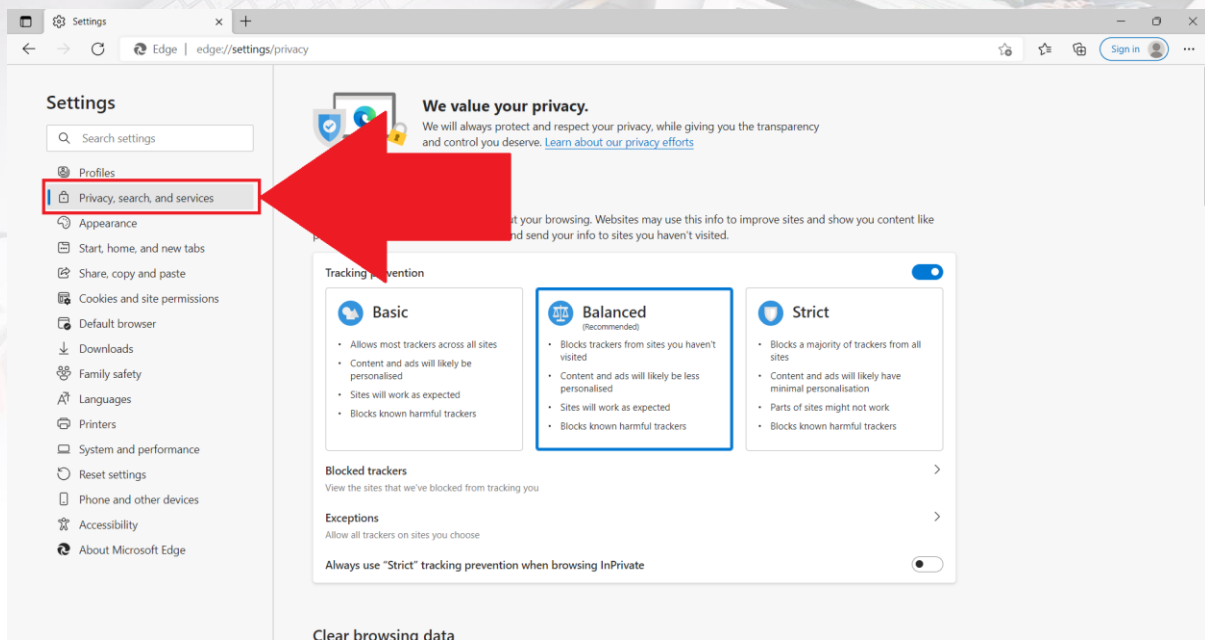
**Step 2.** Click the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner of the browser.



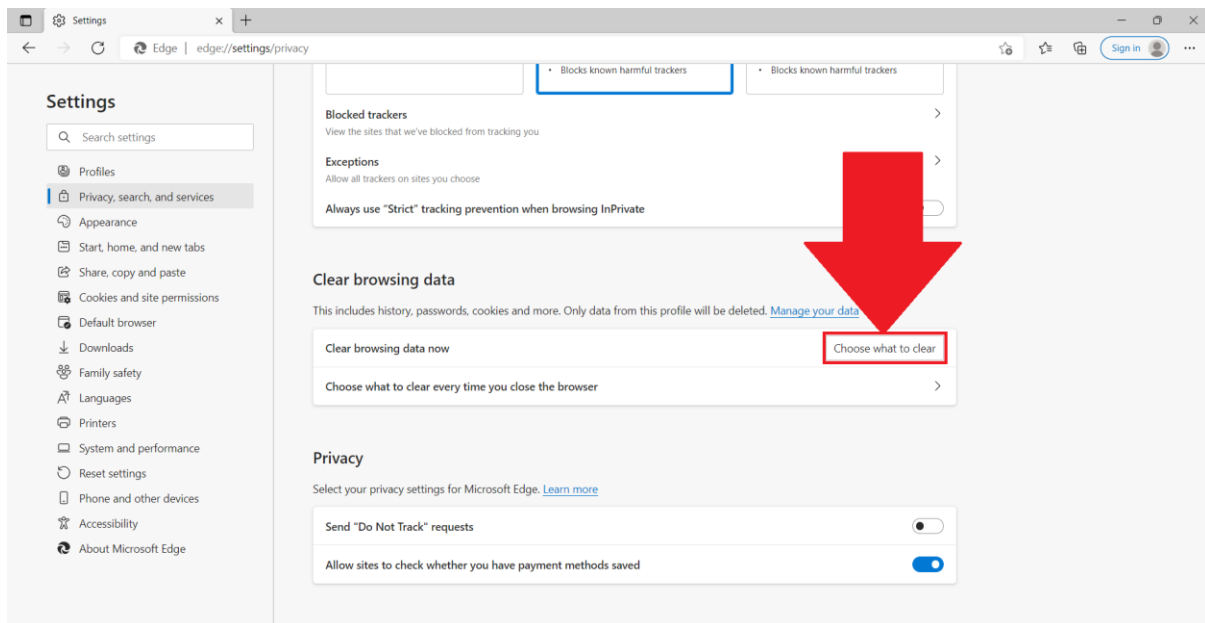
**Step 3.** Select "Settings" from the drop-down menu.



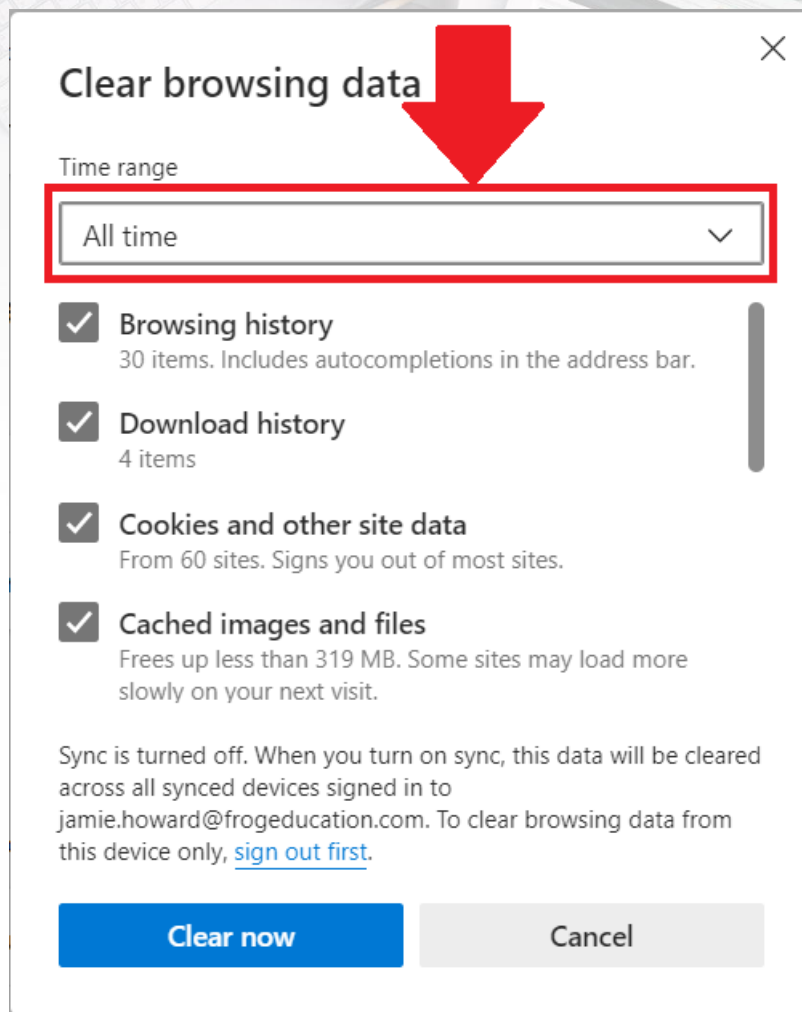
**Step 4.** Select "Privacy, search and services" from the left-hand menu.



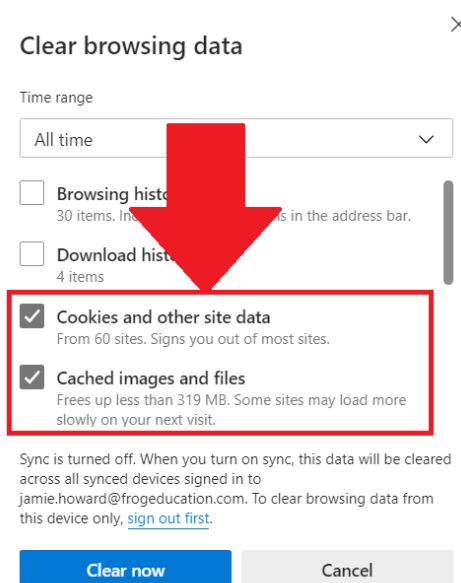
**Step 5.** Scroll down and under the heading "Clear browsing data", click "Choose what to clear".




**Step 6.** In the "Time Range" drop down make sure "All Time" is selected.
