

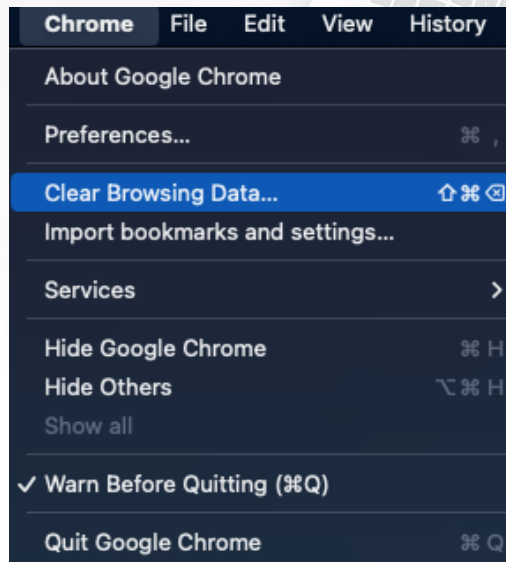

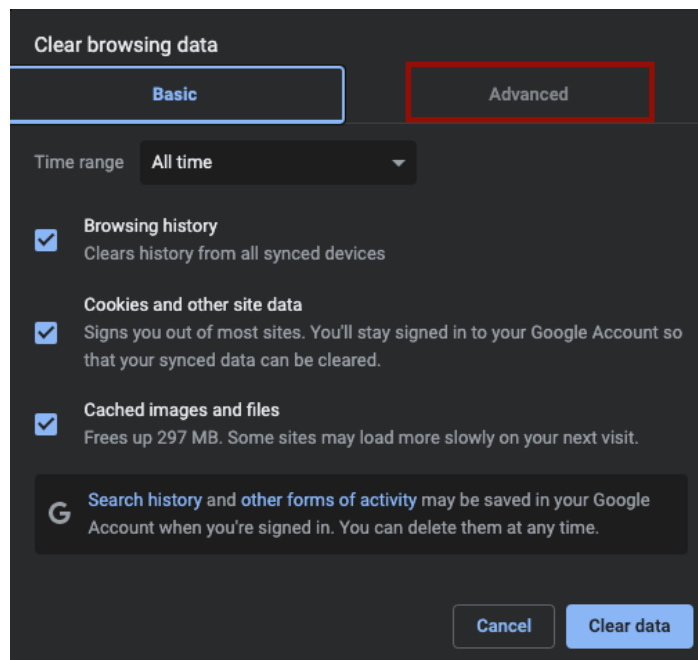

# Chrome

On the following screen, click on Advanced



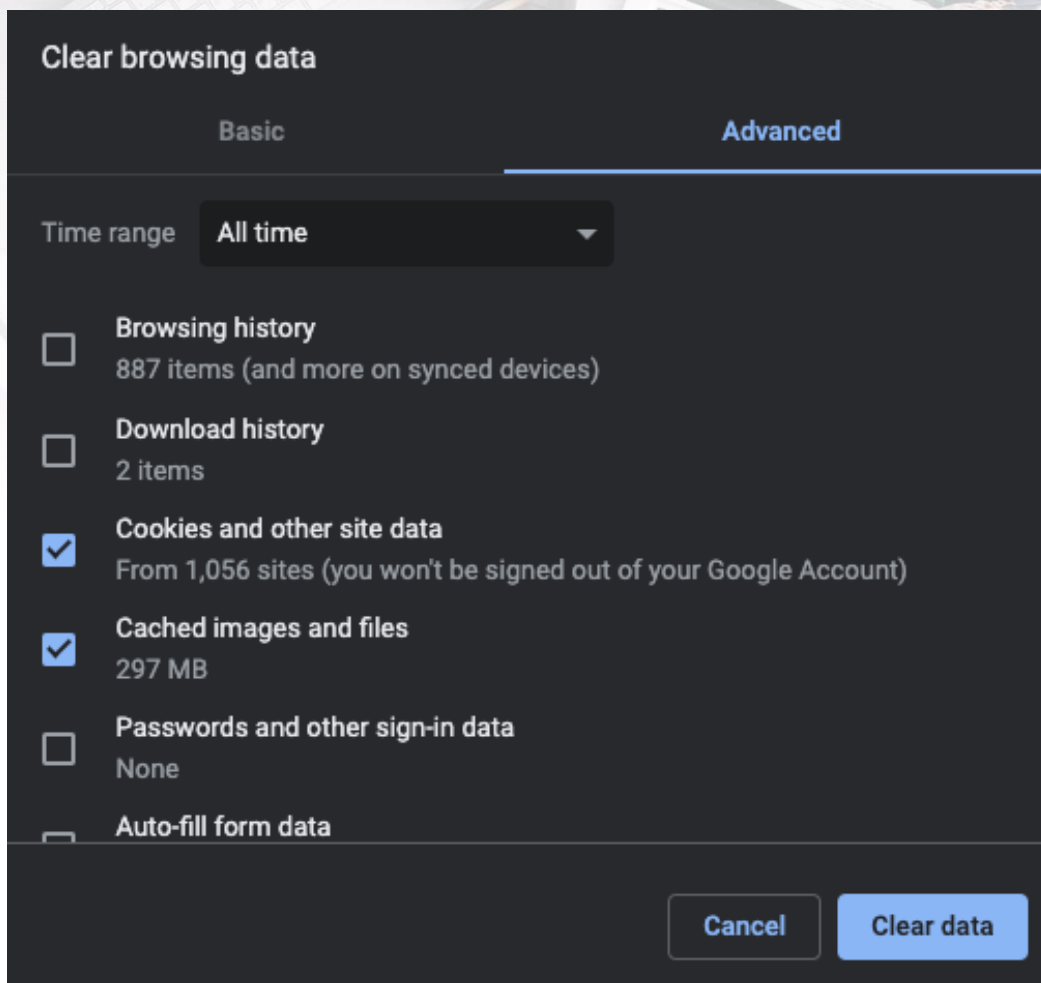
Click on Time range and from the drop down select "All time"

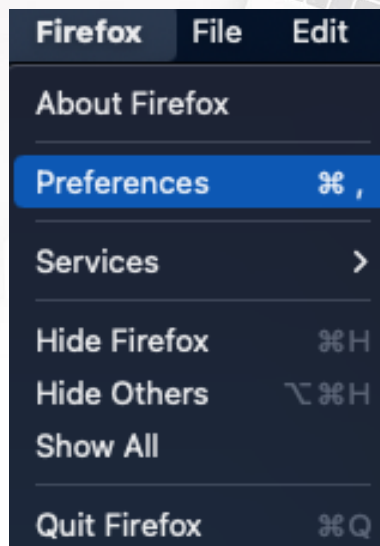

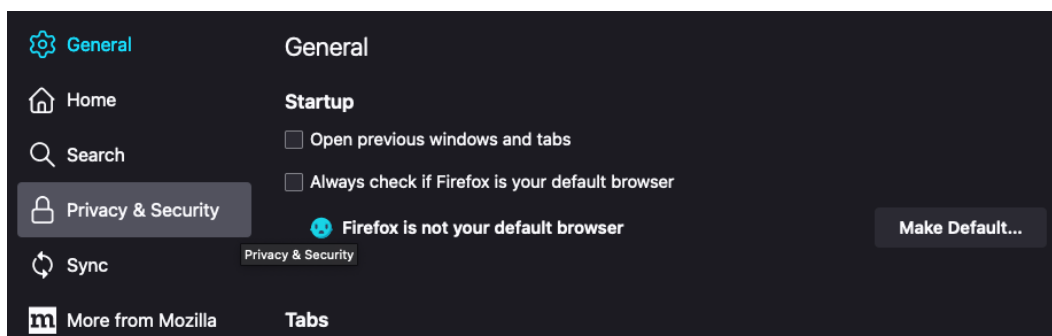
Click on "Clear data" at which point the cookies and cached image file will be deleted.

# Firefox

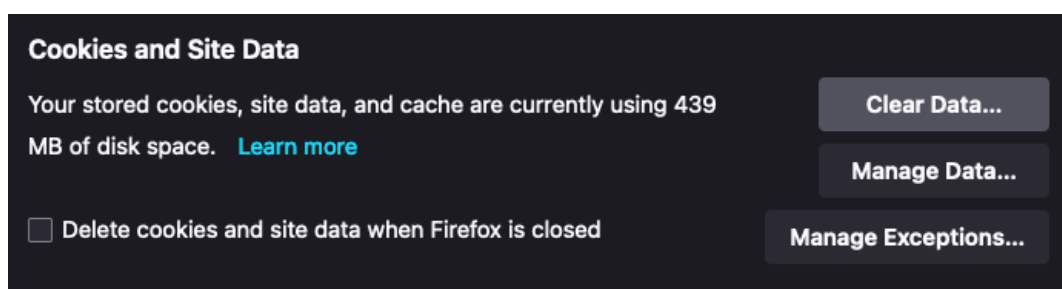
From the menu bar across the top of the screen, click on Firefox and then Preferences

Clearing all cookies and site data stored by Firefox may sign you out of web sites and remove offline web content. Clearing cache data will not affect your logins.

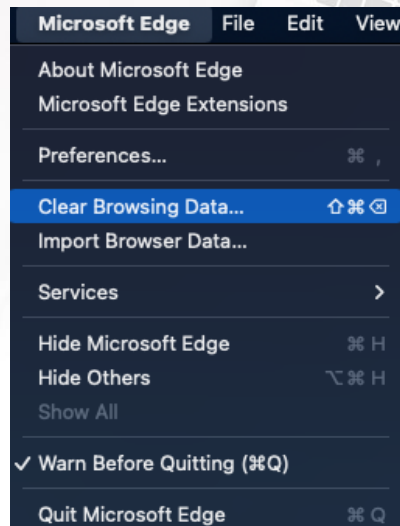

From the menu bar across the top of the screen, click on Microsoft Edge and then "Clear Browsing Data"

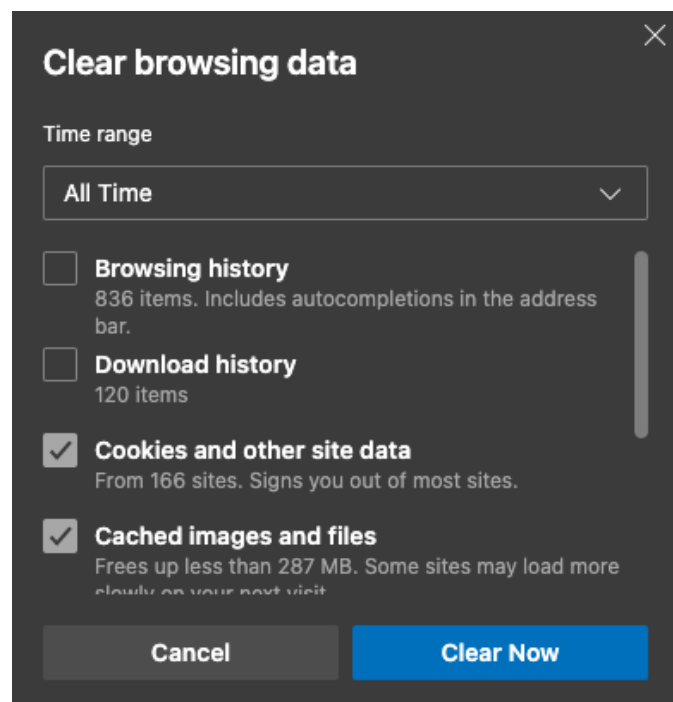


On the following screen, Click on Time range and from the drop down select "All time".

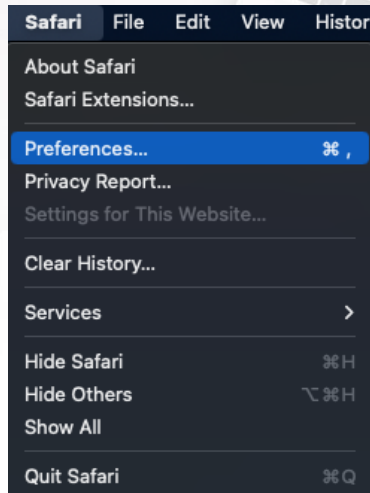

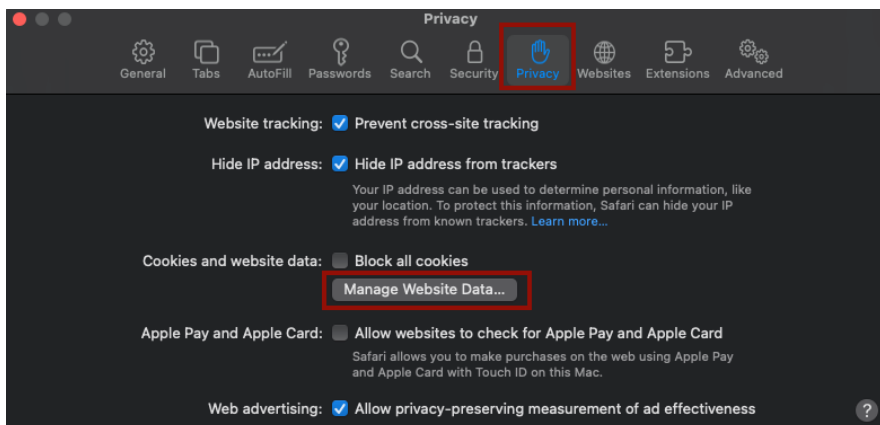
Click on "Clear Now" at which point the cookies and cached image file will be deleted.
