



Behaviour Summary

The behaviour summary widget will display all behaviour information logged against your child. This provides more information than the behaviour totals widget and administrators can choose to display the description of the incident as well as which teacher logged it. As a parent I can select to show all behaviour incidents within a given date range using the select date widget.

If a select date widget is not available on the page, the behaviour summary widget will only display the current months behaviour information.

If you are expecting to see some behaviour information but the 'no data available in given range' message is displayed like in this example, increasing the size of the date range may start to display some results. If increasing this doesn't start to show some information, you may need to contact your school.

Depending on how your school inputs behaviour information, you will see a summary of each incident in the widget. As you can see in this example, there is a red negative and a green positive incident with information on how many points each incident is worth.

In the negative behaviour incident, there are details regarding the type of behaviour logged, the date and time the incident took place, the location, status and the staff member who logged the incident.

The positive behaviour in this example is slightly different as there are details of the award the student has received as a reward for their positive behaviour.
