## Question

The Question widget gives you all the flexibility of Frog's quiz engine, but is limited to a single question.

This is a useful tool when you want to emphasise one particular element of learning. After presenting new information, you are able to provide an interactive check on understanding.

The Question widget comes into its own when the Site is set to Presentation Mode – answering a question can unlock the Next button

You can find the Question widget in the Activities Category.

- Once added to a page, click Create Question.
- A pop-up opens, where you can select the Question type
- I'm going to use a multiple choice question here, but all of the different question types are available.
- Once your question is filled in, and any media or feedback added, click Save.
- The pop-up closes and the question is embedded directly in the page.

**Use as Control** deactivates the Next button when a site is in presentation mode. This forces the user to engage with the question widget. You can choose to unlock the next button if they have attempted it, or only if they answer the question correctly.

The Question widget does not provide a report on user answers or attempts. A quiz would give you that information. When used in Presentation Mode, providing a Form or Poll on a subsequent page and using the Question widget as Control would mean that anyone who submits to the poll or form must have engaged with the Question widget in order to view the next page.
