## Managing Public Access

The Department for Education requires you to publish the content of the curriculum used your school in each academic year for every subject.

You are also required to share how parents and the wider community can find out more about this curriculum.

One of the benefits of Curriculum Designer in Frog, is that we have included a website view of your curriculum. By using Curriculum Designer, not only do you have a simple-to-use collaborative planning space, you also have a live update for this information. Which should save you a lot of work and stress over time.

When setting up your curriculum, with each Key Stage there is the Active/Inactive state. This enables you to choose which curriculum appear within the progression charts and what you publish online. By default, the staff profile hides inactive curriculum. You'll need to use Groups and Policies to grant rights around curriculum designer.

To publish your curriculum, from the front page of Curriculum Designer:

- click on the Action Cog
- Select Manage Public Access
- Toggle the switch for Make Public on the web
- The web address you can link to appear followed by a number of options:
  - You can choose to **only display the KPIs**
  - Which **Key Stages** you wish to publish And scrolling down:
  - You can also decide as a school which elements of the **learning locker** you wish to share.
- Click **Save** once you're happy.

As mentioned, this is on a school-wide basis. You should work with your teachers to ensure everyone is happy with the elements you are publishing. In addition, there are settings within System Preferences for FrogProgress which also control access to the Learning Locker. These are not to do with public access but from within Frog itself.

The published version will look similar to this.

Any changes made in Curriculum Designer will not appear in the public view until the following day. This is a feature designed to ensure optimal performance of the public view. If you wish to see your changes live earlier, then contact Frog's service desk and they will be able to publish your changes.
